

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS
ABOUT
THE ANNUAL RACE 4 LIFE SCAVENGER HUNT

What is the Race 4 Life Scavenger Hunt and where is it? The Race 4 Life Scavenger Hunt is an annual event held each year to create awareness of organ donation and to raise funds that are used in our awareness effort. It is our only fundraising effort each year. It is held at the Rose Garden on Thomas Street in Wausau. This year the event is on April 30, 2011.

What happens during the Scavenger Hunt? A team of four to eight really fun people get together and compete for points, scavenging around the greater Wausau metro area. Points are awarded for bringing back hard to find items, and completing daring tasks. Usually some new 'top secret' addition is included each year to shake things up, and this year will be no different. Past years have found our teams milking cows (by hand), crashing weddings, trying on prom dresses (yes, the guys too) or eating a worm (ick!). Teams have searched high and low for things like an AM radio, a mood ring, tarot cards and pepper spray. Last year they followed clues to various locations around the area to get the next part of their task list. Make sure you bring a digital camera to capture all those tasks!

Who can participate in the Scavenger Hunt? Anyone! Everyone! We have lots of tasks and items to retrieve, so you can select those that are appropriate for your team. It's very family friendly! Teams from past year's scavenger hunts go to great lengths to 'psych out' the competition – you will notice lots of team shirts! So put your team together, design your team shirt, and register! If you want to participate, but can't put together a team, come anyway – there are always some teams who would love to add a little more talent!

How much does the Scavenger Hunt cost and how do I register? The cost is \$35 per person, which includes dinner and the Scavenger Hunt. Printable registration forms can be found on our website. You may also call Ted at 715-574-5771 or Shelby at 715-574-5766 to have one mailed to you. Pledge sheets are also available for those of you who would like assistance raising your entry fee.

What does the winning team get? The winning team gets \$500 cash, individual gold medals and a team trophy. Of course, you also get *bragging rights* for a whole year.

How long does the Scavenger Hunt last? The hunt itself last for four hours – from 1 pm to 5 pm. Teams must be back inside the doors of the Rose Garden by 5 pm to qualify! We start team registration confirmations at noon. During this time, we will go over the rules, take team photos, hand out task lists and have a rousing send off by our emcees, Bryon Graff and Natalie Sparacio. Then it's a mad dash to your cars!

What about the dinner after the hunt? Dinner will be served at 6 pm for all competitors and is included in your entry fee. A cash bar opens at 5 pm. Non-entrants can reserve dinner for \$15 each. Check our website for reservation forms. We ask that those wishing to join us for dinner reserve ahead of time so that we can make sure to have enough dinners available for everyone. Public is welcome!

Is there anything for my younger kids to do after the hunt? Yes, we have a Kidz Korner to keep all those little ones entertained while mom and dad enjoy the evening! *Dottie the Dot* will also be joining us – check her out on our website! We're even having a kids raffle!

What else do you do after the hunt? We have a lot of fun things planned including Yahtzee, raffles, silent auction, drawings for jewelry, a big screen TV, a stocked wine frig, and the infamous 'wheelbarrow of booze' which will take care of all your entertaining needs for quite some time! We also have some guest speakers who will talk about their connection to organ donation, either as a recipient or donor family. Representatives from UW-Madison Organ Procurement Organization will be on site to share information about organ donation, including Trey Schwab, former assistant Marquette basketball coach and double lung recipient.

How soon do I have to let you know that I want to be involved? We would appreciate having team registrations and payments in by April 25, as well as any 'dinner only' reservations – that helps us make sure you have a great time! We filled the Rose Garden to capacity last year, so early registration will assure you of a spot!

Do you ever look for volunteers to help? We do! Volunteers can participate in the scavenger hunt and help out after the Race with the raffles, etc. or you can help during the day by staffing locations around town.
